



## **Colorado EMS Primary Instructor Course Mini Presentation Instructions**

You have been assigned a topic/lesson plan for the required mini presentation. Please read the instructions below to prepare for your presentation.

1. Review the lesson plan. Make sure you are familiar with the content to be delivered. Your audience for this lesson will be considered to be at the First Responder or EMT-Basic level.
2. Think about what strategies you will use to teach this content to a class of students. Research the topic as necessary and bring any materials you will need to assist you in finalizing your presentation.
3. Consider what audio-visuals you will be using. You should bring those materials with you to class. If you do not have access to general audio-visual materials, the session on the evening of Day number one has been structured to assist participants to generate ideas and materials.
4. Attendance at the evening session is required. You may only be excused if all preparations for your presentation are complete and reviewed by a faculty member.
5. Think about your appearance during your presentation. Bring appropriate attire for a professional classroom environment.
6. Mini presentations will begin early on Day number two. All preparations for your presentation must be completed before you arrive for class on that day. This includes copies of handouts, overheads, or requests for equipment or other supplies.
