

MOUTH TO MASK

STEPS TO BE PERFORMED	ACTION/VERBAL RESPONSE	POINTS POSSIBLE	POINTS AWARDED
* Takes or verbalizes appropriate body substance isolation precautions	I will take appropriate BSI precautions.	(1)	
Connects one-way valve to mask	I will place an appropriate one-way-valve to the mask.	(1)	
Opens airway (manually or with adjunct)	I will insure an open airway either manually or by inserting an appropriate airway.	(1)	
Establishes and maintains a proper mask to face seal	I will place the mask over the patient's face and insure a tight seal around the mask.	(1)	
* Ventilates the patient at the proper volume and rate (700-1000 ml per breath/10 to 12 breaths per minute)	I will ventilate the patient once every 5 to 6 seconds or approximately 10 - 12 times per minute. I will watch for chest rise and fall to determine proper tidal volume.	(1)	
NOTE: the examiner must witness ventilations for at least 30 seconds
