STEPS TO BE PERFORMED	ACTION/VERBAL RESPONSE	POINTS POSSIBLE	POINTS AWARDED
* Takes appropriate body substance isolation precautions	I am taking appropriate BSI precautions.	(1)	
Opens patient's airway (head tilt/chin lift or jaw thrust)	I will open the patient's airway.	(1)	
Inserts an airway adjunct	I will insert an airway adjunct.	(1)	
Selects appropriately sized mask	I will select the appropriately sized mask.	(1)	
Creates a proper mask-to-face seal	I will create a proper mask-to-face seal.	(1)	
Ventilates patient at adequate tidal volume and rate (The examiner must witness for at least 30 seconds)	I will ventilate the patient once every five seconds.	(1)	
The examiner indicates arrival of a second EMT. The second EMT is instructed to ventilate the patient while the candidate controls the mask and the airway			
Re-opens the airway	I will re-open the airway.	(1)	
Creates a proper mask-to-face seal	I will create a proper mask-face seal	(1)	
Instructs assistant to resume ventilation at proper volume per breath (The examiner must witness for at least 30 seconds)	I will instruct my assistant to resume ventilation at one breath every five seconds.	(1)
