

**Skill Sheet**  
**Scoop Stretcher**

Skill	Pass	Needs Improvement (Please comment)
1. Takes or verbalizes body substance isolation precautions.		
4. Scoop stretcher measured for patient and divided in half.		
5. One side of scoop is placed under patient. (Patient may be log rolled slightly to facilitate positioning of stretcher.)		
6. Second side of scoop positioned and latches secured.		
7. Straps thorax.		
8. Secures pelvis/hips with straps over iliac crests.		
9. Places padding behind head to maintain neutral position.		
10. Secures blanket rolls, towel rolls, or head immobilizer to scoop.		
11. Places the scoop stretcher on a backboard.		

**Critical Criteria**

- \_\_\_ Scoop sized inappropriately for patient's length
- \_\_\_ Patient moved excessively while being placed on stretcher
- \_\_\_ Patient not secured to stretcher
