Course Description:

The one-day ACLS renewal course is designed for health care providers who have medical training in the treatment of cardiopulmonary emergencies and hold a current ACLS card. This course uses a case-based approach combined with group teaching and evaluation stations designed for adult learners.

Objectives:

- Review BLS skills, including one and two rescuer CPR
- Learn and implement the ACLS algorithms for each of the core cases
- Describe the signs and symptoms of respiratory failure, acute MI and cerebral vascular accidents (CVAs)
- Practice advanced airway skills (endotracheal intubation)
- Interpret EKGs and acute myocardial infarction patterns using 12 lead EKGs
- Identify the indications and use of cardioversion, pacemaker, and manual defibrillators
- Recognize ACLS drug indications / doses / precautions

Required information:

- Students must hold a current American Heart Association ACLS card
- Students must be currently certified as an Intermediate, Paramedic, Nurse, Physician assistant, or Physician.
- The pretest must be successfully passed.
