Course Description:

The eight (8) hour ACLS course is designed for health care providers who have medical training in the treatment of cardiopulmonary emergencies and who hold a current ACLS card and who have completed the American Heart Association (AHA) Core Instructor Course. This course reviews the core cases of ACLS from an instructor point of view and will discuss the presentation methods outlined by AHA. The ACLS course structure and course preparation will be discussed. A teaching practicum is required and must be completed within 90 days of the instructor course.

Objectives:

1. Learn to teach the ACLS algorithms for each of the simulated cases
2. Understand the American Heart Association philosophy
3. Discuss the use of multi-media for class presentation
4. Understand the roles of the assigned positions within the AHA for ACLS

CEUs: 8 hours

Required information:

Students must be a current ACLS cardholder and have a letter of recommendation from an ACLS course director to be eligible to take the instructor course.

Students must be currently certified as an EMT-Intermediate, EMT-Paramedic, Nurse, Physician Assistant, or Physician.

Students must successfully complete the AHA Core Instructor Course prior to attending the class.
