Course Description:

This 5-hour course is provided in accordance with the current American Heart Association (AHA) guidelines and is designed to prepare the BLS provider for a role as a BLS Instructor. This course is open to interested health care workers who have successfully completed the BLS for Healthcare Providers course. Upon completion of this program, the participant will be eligible for Instructor status, pending approval of course faculty and evaluation of performance in both lecture and practical situations.

Objectives:

At the completion of this course the participant will be able to:

1. Discuss the history and organization AHA BLS.
2. Complete the steps necessary to conduct an approved BLS course.
3. Provide samples of both lecture and hands-on teaching for the class.
4. Complete the necessary steps for paperwork submission to the Colorado CPR Association.

Prerequisites:

The participant must be a current AHA BLS provider and have received recognition as an instructor candidate during their provider course or by a current BLS provider or instructor. BLS provider status must be greater than one year from instructor course date. Participant must provide proof of completion of AHA Core Instructor course.
