Course Philosophy

This course fulfills the Colorado Emergency Medical and Trauma Services Section (EMTS) requirements for continuing education for paramedics who wish to renew their certification.

The EMT-P typically provides pre-hospital care in a wide variety of circumstances. This course offers continuing education in all aspects of emergency medical care within the EMT-P scope of practice.

Course Goals

The goals of the Paramedic Refresher Course have been identified as follows:

1. To provide a structured course of review to prepare the student to successfully complete the Colorado State or National Registry renewal process.
2. To provide the refresher student with information on current and emerging topics in emergency medical services.

Objectives

1. Fulfill the requirements to renew as an Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) provider.
2. Apply to the Colorado Emergency Medical and Trauma Services Section for recertification as a paramedic in the state of Colorado.

Course Length

The course is eight – 8 hour days. The following legal holidays are observed: New Years Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

Curriculum

The course exceeds the requirements of the Colorado Emergency Medical and Trauma Services Section for continuing education for EMT-Paramedics. In addition, the course meets the requirements for the National Registry for both initial testing and renewal at the paramedic level.
